On November 11, 1918, the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month, an armistice ended World War I, the "War to end all War's".

In 1954, President Eisenhower signed a bill proclaiming November 11 as Veterans Day. In 1968, Congress moved Veterans Day to the fourth Monday in October. However, it became apparent that the November 11 date was a matter of historic and patriotic significance to a great many Americans. As a result, Congress formally returned the observance of Veterans Day to its traditional date in 1978.

## **Did you Know?**

Did you know that in 2007 the Community Health Nurse administered a total of 490 flu shots to residents, and 149 to Village employees?

Did you know that in 2007, the Department of Public Works spent 1,172 man-hours collecting 11,307 cubic yards of leaves. Also, a total of 1,048 curb miles were street cleaned in 2007.

In 2007, the Shop Elk Grove directory listed 66 outlets in the Village's Business Park. The new Shop Elk Grove directory lists a total of 80 outlets for a net gain of 14 outlets or 21%.
